1. Jehovah-Jireh	The Lord is my Provider.	Gen 2:14
God supplies all of my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Phil 4:19		
2. Jehovah-Rapha	The Lord is my Healer.	Ex 15:26
I have been healed by the stripes of Jesus. 1 Pet 2:24		
3. Jehovah-Shalom	The Lord is my Peace.	Judg 6:24
In the Name of Jesus (NOJ), the peace of God rules in my heart. Col 3:15		
4. Jehovah-Nissi	The Lord is my Banner (Victory).	Ex 17:15
In the NOJ, God is my strength, my personal bravery, & my invincible army. Hab 3:19		
5. Jehovah-Tsidkenu	The Lord is my Righteousness.	Jer 23:6
I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. 2 Cor 5:2		
6. Jehovah-Rohi	The Lord is my Shepherd.	Ps 23:1
In the NOJ, the Lord is my Shepherd and has given me all things that pertain to life and godliness. 2 Pet 1:3		
7. Jehovah-Shammah	The Lord is there (with me).	Ezek 8:35
In the NOJ, the Lord is my Helper and He will never leave me nor forsake me. Heb 13:5,6		
8. Jehovah-Qadash	The Lord is my Sanctifier.	Ex 31:13
In the NOJ, I reckon myself dead to sin but alive to God through Christ Jesus. Rom 6:11		

A. Call on the Name of the Lord.

1. Hallowed (holy) be Thy Name. Matt 6:9
2. Call on Jesus as Savior. Matt 1:21
3. Whosoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved; and your household. Rom 10:9-10

B. Use All the Names of God in Prayer Often.

1. God is also your Heavenly Father, Creator, the Almighty I AM, Redeemer, El Shaddai - More Than Sufficient. Matt 5:48; Gen 1:1; Ex 3:14; Rev 1:8; 1 Cor 1:30; Gen 17:1
2. These Eight Names of God reflect His character demonstrated by Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.
 - a. The Names of God also reveal God's love for us, show His intentions towards us, and His plans for us.
3. Jehovah Shammah is always there with you. Ez 48:35
 - a. Jehovah Shammah is a symbolic name for the earthly Jerusalem.
 - b. This Name of God indicates that God has not abandoned it in ruins after invasion, but promised restoration.
 - c. God promises to dwell with you there forever, Rev 21:3 is ever-present in the New Jerusalem, and even in every challenge you have now.
