

Protection Prayers of Authority

Overview:

We have been given authority in three worlds (Phil 2:10) and nothing of the enemy shall by any means hurt us (Luke 10:19). Both Scriptures are dependent on each other. In these ending days, it behooves us to integrate both fully into our lifestyles.

A. Why Not Those in the Hall of Faith?

Heb 11:35 and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

Heb 11:36 And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

Heb 11:37 They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

Heb 11:39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise.

B. Why Not Paul?

2 Cor11: 23 I am more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

2 Cor11:24 Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one.

2 Cor11:25 Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;

2 Cor11:26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;

2 Cor11:27 In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

C. Prayer Foundations.

1. Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say (*one time*) unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he **saith** (ongoing – lifestyle) shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith (*one time*).

2. Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

3. Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

4. Heb 11:39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: v40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

5. Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected forever them that are sanctified.
6. Washed by the Water of Regeneration.
Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;
Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it (*the church*) with the washing of water by the word, that
Eph 5:27 he might present it to himself a **glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

D. Protection Prayers.

1. Animals.
Every animal is obedient to me. In the Name of Jesus, get out of here.
2. General Protection.
Angels, in the Name of Jesus, I assign you to surround me, my family and our homes (or cars) and protect us 24 hours per day (from all evil from the Kingdoms of Man, Animals, Nature and Darkness).
3. Specific Safety.
In the Name of Jesus, I speak protection around my home and property, and those of my family from all fires, explosion, floods, mud slides, earthquakes, tornadoes, hurricanes, volcanoes, etc.
4. Peace and Protection.
In the Name of Jesus, I bind up every devil, demon and evil spirit (DDE) that has been attacking this person from the outside and cast them out of the country; and I shut up every DDE inside the person for a season. In the Name of Jesus, I speak the peace of Jesus Christ over the person (John 14:27).
5. Dealing with DDEs.
In the Name of Jesus, I bind up every (DDE) which has been attacking me (or my mind) and I cast them out of my house (city, state or country) and/or I cast them into another county, state, country (or out of this country, into a dry place in a far country, into hell, etc.).
6. Authority over Everything.
I thank You, Father, that I was crucified with Christ (Gal 2), buried with Him by Baptism and raised into newness of life by the Glory of the Father (Rom 6), and that the same Holy Spirit Who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me and pumps life into my mortal flesh (Rom 8); and now I live, but not I, Christ Jesus lives in me and the life that I now live in the flesh, I live by the faith of the Son of God Who lives in me; and, since Jesus has the Spirit without measure, then the Spirit without measure abides in me and so I can do all things through Christ Jesus Who strengthens me. In the Name of Jesus, nothing is impossible for me; whatever I believe that I can do or have, then it is possible for me and whatsoever I command comes to pass. Amen.
