| • Loose the Anointing of God (Rivers of Living Water) to flood you and your home. | John 7:38 |
| • Pray that His Knowledge, Kingdom/glory cover all the Earth | Isa 11:9 |

4. Thy Will be done

- Pray for leaders and those in authority. 1 Tim 2:1-3
- Pray for the salvation of all people. 1 Tim 2:4
- Pray for widows, orphans, children James 1:27
- As for you and your house, you all will serve the Lord Josh 24:15
- You call on the Lord and you and your household are saved. Acts 16:31
- Pray God's will be done in your life and home Rom 12:1-2
- Pray God's will for your family and ABC.
- Pray Col 1:9-11

5. Give us this day our daily bread

- Declare that God supplies all your need. Phil 4:19
- Affirm that you have been made rich by the poverty of Jesus. 2 Cor 8:9
- Proclaim the blessings of a tither. Mal 3:10-11
- Affirm that because you give, it shall be given unto you. Luke 6:38
- Command angels to go out and bring money in. Heb 1:14
- Declare the wealth of the sinner has been transferred to you. Prov 13:22

6. Forgive us as we forgive others

- Forgive all who have offended you. Mark 11:22-26
- Ask forgiveness for offenses to others, known/unknown Matt 18:18-35 ****
- Ask forgiveness for all your sins, past, present and future.
- Pray for those who have offended you. Matt 5:44 ****
- If you are struggling with unforgiveness, picture the person in your mind and sing to the person, "Oh, I love you with the love of the Lord.....".
- Pray Ephesians 3:14-21

7. Lead us not into temptation

- Because you pray, you will be kept from temptation. Mark 14:38
- Pray that you will be accounted worthy to escape challenges Luke 21:36
- Declare the Word of God is a lamp/light to your feet/path Ps 119:105
- You acknowledge God and He directs your path. Prov 3:5-6
- Pray Psalm 23

8. Deliver us from evil

- Affirm that you have been healed by the stripes of Jesus. 1 Peter 2:24
- Declare that flood and fire will not harm you or yours Isa 43:2
- Declare that no harm or evil shall befall you. Ps 91:7
- No plague shall come near your dwelling place (home) Ps 91:10
- Affirm that God is for you and no man can harm you. Ps 118:6
- Affirm that no weapon formed shall prosper against you. Isa 54:17
- Pray Psalm 91
