Questions & Answers Bible Study:
Jesus Changes Us All from the Sons of Thunder to Mary Magdalene**

(All scriptures are NKJV)

QUESTION 1: What was Peter's sins that was pushing everyone away?

ANSWER 1: God loves imperfect people like Peter. Some of his sins were: Pride, fear, self-hatred, unworthiness, anger, feeling like a failure not catching any fish, failing to walk on water, and denying Jesus 3x before repenting.

SCRIPTURES:

MATTHEW 14:22-33 - PETER TRIED TO WALK ON WATER. WHY DID HE SINK?

28 And Peter answered Him and said, “Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water.” 29 So He said, “Come.” And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, “Lord, save me!”

31 And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, “O you of little faith, why did you doubt?” 32 And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased.

33 Then those who were in the boat came and worshiped Him, saying, “Truly You are the Son of God.”

MATTHEW 9:33-37 - PETER PRIDEFULLY ARGUED AND FOUGHT WITH THE OTHER DISCIPLES; AND ASKED JESUS WHO IS THE GREATEST.

JESUS REPLIED WHOEVER DESIRES TO BE FIRST, SHALL BE THE LAST AND SERVANT OF ALL; AND WHOEVER RECEIVES THE LITTLE CHILDREN.

33 Then He came to Capernaum. And when He was in the house He asked them, “What was it you disputed among yourselves on the road?” 34 But they kept silent, for on the road they had disputed among themselves who would be the greatest. 35 And He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, “If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all.” 36 Then He took a little child and set him in the midst of them. And when He had taken him in His arms, He said to them, 37 “Whoever receives one of these little children in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me.”

LUKE 5:1-11 THE FIRST TIME THAT JESUS HELPED PETER GET AN ABUNDANCE OF FISH

1 So it was, as the multitude pressed about Him to hear the word of God, that He stood by the Lake of Gennesaret, 2 and saw two boats standing by the lake; but the fishermen had gone from them and were washing their nets. **3 Then He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little from the land. And He sat down and taught the multitudes from the boat. 4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." 5 But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net." 6 And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. 7** So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. 8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" 9 For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; 10 and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men." 11 So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.

JOHN 21:3-14 – THE SECOND TIME THAT JESUS APPEARED TO THE DISCIPLES AND TOLD THEM TO CAST THE NET ON THE RIGHT SIDE, WAS AFTER THE RESURRECTION AND THEY HAD A FISH FRY BREAKFAST TOGETHER!

3 They went out and immediately got into the boat, and that night they caught nothing. 4 But when the morning had now come, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. 5 Then Jesus said to them, "Children, have you any food?" They answered Him, "No." 6 And He said to them, **"Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some."** So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish. 7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, **"It is the Lord!"** Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment (for he had removed it), and plunged into the sea. 8 But the other disciples came in the little boat (for they were not far from land, but about two hundred cubits), dragging the net with fish. 9 Then, as soon as they had come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid on it, and bread. 10 Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish which you have just caught." **11 Simon Peter went up and dragged the net to land, full of large fish, one hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not broken.** 12 Jesus said to them, "Come and eat breakfast." Yet none of the disciples dared ask Him, "Who are You?"—knowing that it was the Lord. 13 Jesus then came and took the bread and gave it to them, and likewise the fish. **14 This is now the third time Jesus showed Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead.**

QUESTION 2: What is the heart of Father God like?

ANSWER 2: God loves each of us, even if one becomes a prodigal son; and welcomes each one back.

SCRIPTURES: LUKE 15:11-32 - THE STORY OF THE PRODIGAL SON

QUESTION 3: What was Jesus' last request to the disciples before he was arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane?

ANSWER 3: 'Couldn't you men keep watch with me for one hour?' ... 'Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.'

SCRIPTURES: MATTHEW 26:40-45 -

40 Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping. **'Couldn't you men keep watch with me for one hour?' he asked Peter. 41 'Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.'**

42 He went away a second time and prayed, 'My Father, if it is not possible for this cup to be taken away unless I drink it, may your will be done.'

43 When he came back, he again found them sleeping, because their eyes were heavy.

44 So he left them and went away **once more and prayed the third time, saying the same thing.**

45 Then he returned to the disciples and said to them, 'Are you still sleeping and resting? Look, the hour has come, and the Son of Man is delivered into the hands of sinners. 46 Rise! Let us go! Here comes my betrayer!'
