The Prosperity Gate

**Overview:** God can do anything except break His Word. His Word states that all things are possible to him who believes. Therefore, miraculous manifestations in your life are constrained only by the limits that you impose upon God by your free will as released through your words and actions.

A. Spiritual Gates and Doors.

1. The Latter Temple.

- a) God's desire has always been to fellowship with His children, first by walking in the garden with Adam and now by living inside of us. We are His temple. 1 Cor 3:16
- b) The design of the Tabernacle of Moses and the Temple of Solomon were based on us.
- c) You are a five-part being, made in the image and likeness of God. Matt 22:37
- d) When your five parts are aligned, God's glory flows out of you. John 7:39
- e) The glory of the latter temple, you, will be greater than Solomon's. Hag 2:9

2. Gates and Doors in the Temple.

- a) Just as the Tabernacle and the Temple had "gates and doors," so do you.
- b) The alignment of your five-part being involves only two gates: the heart and mind.
- c) Your aligned being interacts with the world in a godly manner when the gate of your tongue is also aligned, which is why death and life are in the power of your tongue. Pro 18:21
- d) All the issues of life flow from your heart through your tongue when you are aligned. Pro 4:23

3. The God of Glory.

- a) Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Psa 24:7
- b) Your heart, soul and mind are the gates and doors which allow the King of Glory to manifest His power and blessings in our lives.
- c) When your heart is filled with love, the grafted word in your heart will set your soul free and you are filled with the fullness of God. God is then free of the limits that you normally set on Him and He can flood you with supernatural blessings. Jam 1:21  
Eph 3:19

4. A Lifestyle of Glory.

- a) Your job is to have a lifestyle with your gates so aligned that the glory of God will flood out of you as torrential Rivers of Living Water. 2 Chr 5:14

B. The Prosperity Gate.

1. What is the Prosperity Gate?

- a) When your heart, soul, mind and tongue are aligned, the anointing flows into your words, imparting great power over the kingdoms of the world, except for one kingdom. Gen 1:26
- b) You have been given authority and dominion over the kingdoms of the earth and satan has been defeated, so his kingdom is under your feet. Gen 1:28  
Col 2:15
- c) However, man has free will, is not under your authority, and has created the Kingdom of Mammon (KOM) (i.e., the sum total of all that man has created to live on this earth).
- d) The Kingdom of Mammon (KOM) is man's solution to addressing the problems of the world in order to have his needs met, but it is a solution without God.
- e) Originally, the KOM was based on bartering but today all its systems are now powered by money. **Money, then, is the final gate which must be aligned for prosperity.**

2. The Kingdom of Mammon (Mammon).

- a) Because mammon is man's physical, carnal attempts to achieve worldly success by using the things of this world instead of relying on God, then it is unrighteous.
- b) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 1Jn 2:16

- c) Your interaction with the Kingdom of Mammon is through money, which is the medium by which these systems operate, evidenced in the saying, “Money makes the world go round.”
  - d) Money is so important in the carnal world that the Bible teaches that the love of money is the root of all evil. 1Tim 6:10
  - e) Loving money is being sold out to mammon, which is enmity with God, because friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God. Jam 4:4
3. Choose to Serve God or Mammon.
- a) No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. Mat 6:24
  - b) If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? Luk 16:11
  - c) Since money is the gate for using mammon, your faithfulness to God will be shown by how you handle your money. This is why the tithe is so important.
  - d) Loving money is a commitment to a lifestyle which is focused on mammon and is an idolatrous life of walking by sight.
  - e) Consecrating your money and being led by the Holy Sprit in your use of money is walking by faith. This is the process of aligning the money gate.
4. Prospering through Alignment.
- a) The alignment of your heart, soul, mind, tongue & money allows God’s anointing to flow out of you to change your circumstances so that God can delight in your prosperity. Ps 35:27

C. Opening the Gate to Supernatural Provisions.

God’s power is released through the gate of your tongue, when what you say lines up with God’s Word. Similarly, God’s power is released through the gate of your money, when your money is spent in line with God’s Word. Alignment of your money releases supernatural provisions in your life.

1. Consecrate your money.
  - a) You cannot serve God and money (Lk 6:13). Serving mammon means loving money. 1Tim 6:10
    - But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions. Mat 19:22
  - b) Neither your money nor any possessions should come between you and God. Luk 14:33
    - So then, any of you who does not forsake (renounce, surrender claim to, give up, say good-bye to) all that he has cannot be My disciple. AMPC
2. Be a tither or be cursed. Mal 3:8-10
  - a) Choose life/death, blessing/curse; not tithing is a curse, so tithing must be a blessing. Deu 30:19
3. Be a cheerful, forgiving, loving giver.
  - a) It is more blessed to give than to receive. Why? Because giving sets you up for supernatural provisions since it aligns your money gate. Acts 20:35
4. Expect Greater Miracles.
  - a) When your four gates (heart, mind, tongue, money) are aligned, God’s anointing flows out to do whatever is necessary (e.g., Jesus and the fish; Peter’s shadow; and Paul’s handkerchiefs). Mt 17:27  
Acts 5:15  
Acts 19:12
  - b) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. Joh 14:12
  - c) And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. Joh 14:13
  - d) If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. Joh 14:14
