1. In Amos 9, captivity in a foreign land brought to an end the old division, between the northern state of Israel and the southern state of Judah. God brought the reunited people back into their land, where they lived in security and prosperity. (Bridgeway Bible Commentary).
 - a. Matt 12:25 (AMPC) [Jesus] said to them, any kingdom that is divided against itself is being brought to desolation and laid waste, and no city or house divided against itself will last or continue to stand.
 - b. They inhabited the waste or ruined cities, rebuilt, planted vineyards, made their gardens and they flourished with abundance. They planted on their land and God told them they would never again be uprooted from the land that God had given them.
 - c. God gave the united Israelite exiles more blessings after they were freed from captivity because they became obedient and started to seek God for help.
 - d. Are there dreams or goals that were tossed or seemed stagnated or hindered that have not been producing successful fruit like in Amos 9:14-15 when the Israelites returned and found deserted and ruined cities?
 - e. Make sure those dreams and goals are from God and aligned with Him.
 - f. Because if they are not, they will wither and dry up without God's blessings.
 - g. What areas of your life do you want God to rebuild the old ruins and repair what you thought was desolate or that caused depression or discouragement?
 - h. When you have that confirmation of what God wants you to do or rebuild, affirm it to get more blessings.
 - i. Affirm Amos 9:14-15 (Amplified) and Isa 61:4: In the Name of Jesus, the goals and dreams given to me by God is being rebuilt to produce abundant fruit which means it will be exceedingly successful. In addition, God has firmly planted me where He wants me to be in my land where I am fulfilling my calling; and I will not be uprooted from the what God has given me.

2. Affirm Ez 36:23: In the Name of Jesus, God's Name is always sanctified as I proclaim Him and I am not ashamed of the Gospel. All nations shall know that He is my God and I give all the glory to Him in everything I do.
3. Affirm Ez 36:24-26: In the Name of Jesus, thank You, God, for giving us our own land, our own place where You want us to be. Thank You, Lord, for cleansing me and my life, as well as, giving me a a new heart and putting a new spirit within me, for You have taken the heart of stone out of my flesh and has given me a heart of flesh.
4. Affirm Joel 2:25-26 (AMPC): In the Name of Jesus, I am grateful, Lord, that You have been restoring or replacing, for me, the years of devastation that the locust has eaten. I am thankful that Your blessing is upon me and my loved ones so that we can eat in plenty, be satisfied and praise Your Name, our God for You have dealt wondrously with us; and we, Your people, shall never be put to shame.
5. Affirm Prov 6:30-31 (AMPC): In the Name of Jesus, the devil who is a thief, must restore seven times what he stole from me; and he must also give me the whole substance of his house to me. That means that the devil must pay me back a sevenfold the complete compensation for restitution now, of everything he has ever stolen from me, including _____ (*Fill in the blank. Example: my health and healing, my joy, my reputation, my prosperity, etc.*)
6. Affirm Job 8:7 (CEV): In the Name of Jesus, my future will be brighter by far than my past.
7. Affirm Haggai 2:9 (AMPC): The latter days of my life, will be greater and more glorious than the former; and God will continually give me peace and prosperity.
8. Affirm Luke 6:38 (Amplified): In the Name of Jesus, *{when I give extra offerings above my tithes to God}*, it will be given to me. Other people will pour into my lap a good measure — pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For with the standard of measurement I use, it will be measured to me in return and given back with bonus and blessings (MSG).
9. Affirm Eph 1:3: In the Name of Jesus, blessed be the God and Father of my Lord Jesus Christ, who continues to bless me with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.
10. Affirm Num 6:24-26 (KJV, Amplified, MSG): In the Name of Jesus, the Lord blesses me and keeps me. He protects me, sustains me, and guards me. The Lord makes His face shine upon me [with favor], and is gracious to me [surrounding me with lovingkindness] {and mercy}, the Lord lifts up His countenance upon me, gives me peace, and makes me prosper.
