A. Level 1: Seek First the Kingdom of God and His Righteousness.

- 1. Characteristics: Provides basic food, clothing, shelter and protection.
- 2. Scriptures:
 - Mat 6:31-33 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? 32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. 33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- 3. **Actions:** Live in the Kingdom of God by living with Jesus as Lord and being obedient to his Word and Spirit. Confess sins, USP regularly, Establish the Kingdom of God, spend time in the Word, Pray in tongues, spend time with the Father.

B. Level 2: Tithing

- 1. Characteristics: Provides an abundance of your basic needs, requiring enlarging your territory.
- 2. Scriptures:
 - Mal 3:10-11 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. 11 And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.
- 3. **Actions:** Give a tithe of all that you receive. Pray over your tithe according to Deut 26:13-15 (that God will bless you in this land of milk and honey).

C. Level 3: Offerings

- 1. Characteristics: Returns 30, 60 and 100 fold if given into the Gospel. Given above the tithe which allows God's grace to abound and abundantly supply every good work. **Live to Give**.
- 2. Scriptures:
 - Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
 - Gal 6:6-7 Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things. 7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.
 - 2 Cor 8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.



- 2 Cor 9:6-8 But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. 7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. 8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: Prov 22:9 He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor.
- 3. **Actions:** Give at every opportunity to be a blessing to those in need, to bless the people of God, and the ministry of God's Word. Give as led by the Spirit who will guide your steps.

D. Level 4: Working Diligently.

- 1. Characteristics: Makes you rich. Avoid procrastination, laziness, excuses, pride. Be proactive. Be meek. Be diligent. Work as unto the Lord. Seek to be a blessing.
- 2. Scriptures:

Prov 10:4-5 He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich. 5 He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame.

Col 3:22-24 Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God: 23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; 24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. Prov 6:6-8 Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: 7 Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, 8 Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest.

Prov 26:13-15 The slothful man saith, There is a lion in the way; a lion is in the streets. 14 As the door turneth upon his hinges, so doth the slothful upon his bed. 15 The slothful hideth his hand in his bosom; it grieveth him to bring it again to his mouth.

Eph 4:28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. Phil 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

3. Actions: Tithing and giving offerings begins the flow of prosperity into our lives. Diligence destroys the hindrances that stop the flow. Look at your life and your actions as it relates to money. Attitudes of entitlement (even from God), laziness, excuses, procrastination, etc. blocks the flow. On the other hand, a hand of diligence (no pun intended) will begin to destroy the dam. What can you do differently on your job, or in your life to be more diligent in the what the Lord has called you to do. Implement Interval Living and the Covenant Matrix into your life every day.



E. Level 5: Living in Humility.

- 1. Characteristics: Provides riches in God's way.
- 2. Scriptures:

Ps 10:17 LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:

Ps 25:9 The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way. 1 Pet 5:5-6 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. 6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: 7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

Prov 22:4 By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life. Prov 26:16 The sluggard is wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

3. **Actions:** Humble yourself before God, his Word, and before others (esteem others as more important then yourself). The outward attribute of humility comes from the inward attribute of meekness. Meekness comes from a Greek word that means power under control. The spiritual opposite of pride is love – true meekness comes from love; love God and love others (Matt 22:37-39). Pray 1 Cor 13:4-8 daily – In the name of Jesus, because of God's love in me...

F. Level 6: Living in the Reverential Fear of the Lord.

- 1. Characteristics: Wealth comes with God's wisdom.
- 2. Scriptures:

Duet 8:17-18 And thou say in thine heart, My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth. 18 But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

Prov 22:4 By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life. Prov 2:1-9 My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee; 2 So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to understanding; 3 Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, and liftest up thy voice for understanding; 4 If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as for hid treasures; 5 Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. 6 For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding. 7 He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: he is a buckler to them that walk uprightly. He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints. 9 Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path.



Prov 3:13-35

Prov 8:18-21 Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.

- 19 My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver. 20 I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:
- 21 That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.

Prov 15:33 The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is humility.

Ps 19:9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.

3. **Actions:** Walking in the fear of God puts us in a position to desire to please God above all else, to do everything His way. Pray Prov 2:1-9 daily so that the cry of your heart is to know God and walk only in His ways.

G. Level 7: Living in God's Wisdom.

1. Characteristics: We abound to every good work, increasing in fruitfulness and in the knowledge of God. Giving of all we are and have for the benefits of the kingdom.

Give to Live

- 2. Scriptures:
 - 1 Cor 2:16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.
 - 1 Cor 1:13 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

Prov 3:13-35

- 2 Cor 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:
- Col 1:9-10 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- 3. **Actions:** Our whole life is wrapped up in God, He and His kingdom is all we live for. Diligently look for ways to give your life and all you have to serve others. Giving becomes as natural and automatic as breathing.
