Releasing the Anointing in You

Overview: The Anointing destroys the yoke of bondage by confirming the Word when it is spoken in faith out of a heart of faith.

A. The Anointing and the Word

The Anointing is the power of God manifested for a specific purpose.

1. The Word does not function by itself.
 - a) The Written Word and the mental Word (i.e., in your mind) have little or no spiritual impact.
 - b) If there is iniquity in your heart, God will not hear you. Psalm 66:18
 - c) If your heart condemns you, your prayers won't be answered. 1 John 3:20-22
2. The Word works with the Anointing of God.
 - a) Light be; and the Spirit of God moved. Gen 1:2,3
 - b) Let us create man; God breathed into man the breath of life. Gen 1:26, 2:7
 - c) Confess with your mouth to be born again; born of water and Spirit. Rom 10:9; Joh 3:5,6
 - d) The Word was made flesh, but the Holy Spirit remained on Him. John 1:14, 33
 - e) Bind the strong man; anointing destroys the yoke. Mt 12:29; Isa 10:27
3. Faith connects the Word with the Anointing.
 - a) Word of Faith is nigh; but we began in the Spirit. Rom 10:8; Gal 3:2,3
 - b) As He was teaching, the power was present to heal. Luke 5:17
 - c) Jesus said to the woman (with issue), thy faith has made thee whole. Mark 5:34
 - d) In Nazareth, Jesus taught in synagogue but could do no mighty work. Mark 6:2,5,6
 - e) The Word was not mixed with faith. Heb 4:2
 - f) Be hearers and doers, for those who are not doers deceive themselves. James 1:22

B. Aligning Your Gates to Release the Anointing

1. The King of Glory
 - a) God, the King of Glory, lives in you, His temple. 1 Cor 3:16
 - b) The glory of the latter house shall be greater than the former. Hag 2:9
 - c) God wants His glory to flow out of you and to change you & those around you as His glory changed Moses so that he was shining. Ex 34:35
 - d) You are the doors and the gates which control how much of God's glory comes out of you to flood the world around you. Ps 24:6-10
2. Holiness unto the Lord
 - a) Holiness, a product of submission, aligns your gates and doors. Jam 4:7, 1 Pet 5:5
 - b) Be perfect and holy as Your Father is. Matt 5:48, 2 Cor 7:1
 - c) Perfect in Jesus. Col 1:28
 - d) For this reason, add to yourselves... that you may never fall. 2 Peter 1:5, 8-10
3. The Cycle of Change
 - a) Your structure
 - 1) Overall, you are a spirit, with a soul and you live in a body. 1 Thes 5:23
 - 2) Jesus said to love God with your heart, soul and mind. Matt 22:37
 - 3) Jesus said that you are justified by your words. Matt 12:37
 - 4) The heart, mind and tongue are your gates/doors.

- b) Your Gates/Doors
 - 1) The heart is the gate from the spirit to the rest of your being. Pro 4:23
 - 2) The mind is the gate from your body to the rest of your being. Rom 8:7
 - 3) The tongue is the gate from you to the rest of the world. James 3:2-4
- c) Aligning your gates
 - 1) Renew your mind to the Word of God. Rom 12:2
 - 2) The Word is deposited into your heart when you act on the Word in your mind. James 1:25
 - 3) Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaks. Matt 12:34
 - 4) The heart teaches the mouth and tongue. Pro 16:23
 - 5) Whosoever keeps his tongue, keeps his soul. Pro 21:23
 - 6) Prosper and be in health as your soul prospers. 3 John 2
- d) Results of the alignment
 - 1) When your gates/doors are aligned, the anointing flows from the Holy Spirit in your spirit through your heart all the way through to your tongue to change your soul, your body, your health, your finances and your world.
 - 2) Affirming healing brings healing manifestations.(Tit 3:8) 1 Pet 2:24
 - 3) The anointing drives sickness and disease out of your body. Rom 8:11
 - 4) Peter's shadow healed people. Acts 5:15
 - 5) Paul's prayer cloths, handkerchiefs or aprons healed the sick. Acts 19:12

C. Speaking Anointed Words

- 1. Anointed Words
 - a) The anointing abideth in you. 1 John 2:27
 - b) Bible Words or Spirit-led Words always carry an anointing. 1 Pet 1:23
 - c) Speaking them when you are aligned increases the anointing.
 - d) Speaking them when God wants them spoken increases the anointing to the point of manifesting miracles, signs and wonders.
- 2. Confirmation of the Word
 - a) His Word shall not return void to Him, but it shall accomplish Isa 55:11
 - b) The Holy Spirit confirms the spoken Word. Mark 16:20
- 3. Benefits of Speaking Anointed Words
 - a) You can change your world and the world. Mark 11:23
 - b) You can call things that be not as though they were. Rom 4:17
 - c) You can curse and kill cancer and other life-threatening organisms. Mark 11:21
 - d) You can speak life to people, animals and plants. Pro 18:21
 - e) You can speak life, and not death, to yourself. Pro 15:4
 - f) You can live under the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus and avoid death by living free of the Law of Sin and Death. Rom 8:2
 - g) You can live until Jesus returns and be raptured. 1 Thes 4:17
