

Consistency in Overcoming

A. Definition

1. Webster: Consistency is steady conformity to character, profession, belief or custom; steady continuity; free from irregularity.
2. General: Keep doing what you are supposed to be doing without change, interruption, wavering, or giving up.
3. ABC: Persistent execution without wavering despite opposition.

B. Consistency in Achieving Goals

1. God never changes. Mal 3:6
2. Unity never changes, for then it would not be unity. Gen 11:6 Acts 2:1
3. Prayer of Agreement requires both parties to agree and not change the agreement. Matt 18:19
4. You never change. **Your word is your covenant**, your bond, your contract. Don't break it.
5. Ask in faith without wavering for double-minded men receive nothing from God. Jam 1:6-8

C. Consistency in Becoming Christ-like

- To him who has, to him will be given **more abundance** (Matt 13:12). Don't draw back Heb 10:38*
1. Be a disciple (i.e., continue in the Word to be set free). John 8:31-32
 - a) The engrafted Word is your spiritual fuel, like coal to a furnace. Jam 1:21
 - b) The engrafted Word is the power to your sword, like gas to a car.
 - c) The engrafted Word is dynamite to your mountain, like ammunition to a gun.
 2. Give the Word of God top priority in your life.
 - a) Be consistent in letting the Word of God guide your speech. Matt 12:34
 - b) Be consistent in letting the Word of God guide your life. Ps 119:105
 - c) Be consistent in studying the Bible, attending church, tithing, praying, warfare. Mal 3:10
 3. Be committed to growing spiritually by feeding on the Word.
 - a) Master the process of feeding on the **milk** of the Word by living it. 1 Pet 2:2
 - b) Grow on the **meat** of the Word by getting your HD degree (i.e., Hear and Do). 1 Cor 3:1-3
 - c) Mature into feeding on **strong meat** by having your senses exercised to discern both good and evil. This comes through use. Practice makes perfect. Heb 5:14

D. Consistency in Overcoming

1. Consistency in preparation for warfare.
 - a) Be instant in season (i.e., always be ready for warfare). 2 Tim 4:2
 - b) Stay in the Kingdom of God by consistently living Godly principles. Rom 14:17
 - c) Be consistent to be always prayed up (i.e., **remain under the anointing**). Jude 1:20
2. Consistency during warfare.
 - a) Consistency is mandatory for spiritual warfare; keep using your weapons despite opposition. Every time you resist sin, it strengthens your will. Eph 6:18
Moderate consistency is much better than irregular extremes.
 - b) Be consistent by counting it all joy when you come under diverse attacks. Jam 1:2-4
The Lord is the strength of your life (Ps 27:1); His joy is your strength. Neh 8:10
In His presence is fullness of joy. **Maintain your joy.** Ps 16:11
 - c) Consistently act like an adult in God's family by being led by the Holy Spirit. Rom 8:14
Never run from God. Always be led by the Spirit of God. The demons don't really care what you do as long as you obey them.
3. Consistency in maintenance after warfare.
 - a) Don't kick back after the victory and wallow in your flesh. Josh 1:8
 - b) Continue studying the Word and doing your maintenance affirmations. Ps 1:2-3
 - c) Continue to do at a reduced level the same Secondary Methods of Healing and Warfare which brought your victory.
