A. What is “Standing in Faith”?

Eph 6:13-14

- 1) Standing in Faith (SIF) refers to what you do between the “Amen” of your prayer and the “There it is” of seeing the manifestation with your eyes (senses).
- 2) SIF is not a passive attitude of “whatever will be, will be” but a military attitude and stance.
- 3) SIF is a time of spiritual warfare, wherein you aggressively prevent the devil from stealing the birthing of God’s promise to you.
- 4) SIF is a time of “not doubting in your heart”. Mark 11:23
- 5) SIF is a process of “calling things that be not, as though they were’ until they are. Rom 4:17
- 6) SIF is the execution of your Faith Action Plan (FAP).

B. When do you Stand in Faith?

- 1) SIF begins at the Point of Contact when you released your faith by saying “Amen”.
- 2) SIF begins at the conclusion of a Primary Prayer (e.g. Prayer of Faith, Agreement, & Authority. Others are: Anointing with oil, Laying of hands & Gifts of the Spirit.).
- 3) SIF begins when “You believed that you received when you prayed”.
- 4) SIF begins when you say “Amen” i.e., “So let it be”.
- 5) SIF begins when you start looking for the manifestation.
- 6) SIF begins when you start executing the FAP with ardent zeal & intense exertion. Mt 11:12Am

C. How do you Stand in Faith?

- 1) You Stand in Faith (Stand) by living the FAP, speaking/acting as if you have already received.
- 2) You stand by doing spiritual warfare, using the Secondary Methods of Prayer (Confessing sins, P&W, Communion, Bible reading, tongues, fasting, breaking curses, casting out demons).
- 3) You start with affirmations, which are words consistent with your belief. Tit 3:8
- 4) You stand knowing that Faith and Patience are the Power Twins. Heb 6:12
- 5) You stand by meeting every challenge with joyful endurance and consistency. James 1:2-4
- 6) Your stand by walking by faith (i.e. by doing your FAP) 2 Cor 5:7
and not by walking by sight (i.e., speaking the problems or circumstances).
