Praying as a Lifestyle

A. Overview

1. The Five Verses are Mark 11:22-26 and are taught at five levels.
 - a) Prayer of Faith
 - b) Prayer of Agreement
 - c) Prayer of Authority
 - d) Prayer of Creation
 - e) Prayer of Dominion.

B. Characteristics of an Overcoming Christian

1. God is your Father, your Abba Daddy. Act like it. Gal 4:1-7
2. You have been forgiven all your sins. Forgive all others. Rom 6:11
3. You are a super-conqueror, a winner. Winners never quit. Rom 8:37
4. Your tongue controls your life. You have what you say, so speak what you want. Jam 3:2-4
5. Death and life are in the power of your tongue. Keep God's Word in your mouth. Eph 4:29

C. Five Verses as a Lifestyle of Prayer

1. Mark 11:22 Have Faith in God.
 - a) Trust God. Acknowledge Him in all your decisions.
 - b) Believe as God does that whatever He says comes to pass.
 - c) Believe as God does that you have authority over your world and all in it.
 - d) Believe as God does that your words create your world.
 - e) Lean your entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence. Heb 6:12 Amp
2. Mark 11:23 Believe that every word you speak comes to pass.
 - a) (KJV) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
 - b) (ABC) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say [**as an individual occurrence (G2036)**] unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith [**as an ongoing lifestyle (G3004)**] shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith [**as an individual occurrence (G2036)**].
 - c) G3004 Lay forth or relate as in a systematic or set discourse.
 - d) G2036 An individual expression of speech. (Strong's Concordance)
3. Mark 11:24 Pray for God's help in every situation.
 - a) (KJV) Therefore I say (G3004) unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
 - b) (ABC) Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them [**at the point of time when you prayed (i.e., see it done spiritually with your eye of faith)**], and ye shall have them (**in the future manifested physically to your natural eyes**).
4. Mark 11:25-26 Be a forgiving person and speak blessings.
 - a) Check for offense and/or unforgiveness every time you interact with someone or every time you start to lose your joy, peace or patience.
 - b) In the Name of Jesus, forgive each offender from your heart and bless them from your heart.
 - c) If the memory of the offense keeps returning, then bind the mercy of God to the person.
