- Foundation Scripture:** The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16b
- A. A Fervent Prayer is an Anointed Prayer
1. Webster Definition: very hot or exhibiting deep sincere emotions. 1King 18:41-46
 2. Scripturally, “fervent” would be synonymous with “anointed” since the anointing destroys the yoke of bondage. Isa 10:27
- B. Fundamentals of the Anointing
1. Who
He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit,)
John 7:38
John 7:39
 2. What
Anointing is the presence of the Holy Spirit, manifested for a specific purpose. Luke 5:17
 3. When
The Holy Spirit works with and confirms the Word with signs and wonders. Mark 16:18
 4. Where
The anointing will manifest wherever faith is released. Mk 5:28, 6:56
 5. Why
The anointing destroys the yoke of bondage. Isa 10:27
Not by might nor by power but by the Holy Spirit. Zec 4:6
 6. How
Submit yourself to God, resist the devil and he will flee. Jam 4:7
The anointing on Jesus set the captives free. Luke 4:18, Acts 10:38
- C. Living in the Anointing of God is a Lifestyle
1. Releasing the Anointing.
 - a) Confess your sins. 1 John 1:9
 - b) Forgive others. Matt 6:12-15
 - c) Delight in the Lord. Psalm 1:2-3
 - d) Speak the Word of God. Mark 11:23
 - e) Pray according to His promises. 1 Jn 5:14-15
 - f) Preach/teach the Word of God. Mark 16:20
 - g) Be a tither. Mal 3:10-11
 - h) Give offerings. Acts 10:4
 - i) Breaking curses. Ex 34:7
 2. Building the Anointing.
 - a) Pray with affirmations of the Word of God. Tit 3:8
 - b) Worship God in spirit (singing with or without the understanding). 2 Chr 5:13-14
 - c) Worship God in your body; Dance (Ps 150:4), Lifting holy hands 1 Tim 2:8
 - d) Reading the Bible (especially aloud). Joshua 1:8
 - e) Abide in Him John 15:7
 - f) Receive Communion. 1 Cor 11:23-26
 - g) Fasting Isa 58:6-8
 - h) Pray in Tongues. 1 Cor 14:4, Jude 1:20
