

How to Develop Stronger Faith to Become a Super Conqueror

A. What is a Super Conqueror in Christ Jesus?

1. You are more than a conqueror through Him (Jesus) that loved us. Rom 8:37
 - a) Greek for “more than conquerors” is hypernikao /
 Strong’s Concordance G5228 (Latin root) hyper = super
 G3590 nikao = overcome, conquer, prevail, get the victory

B. Why do you want to become a Super Conqueror in Christ Jesus?

1. There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, Rom 8:1
 who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
2. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the Rom 8:2
 law of sin and death.
3. That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not Rom 8:4
 after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
4. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life Rom 8:6
 and peace.
5. Because the carnal mind is enmity (opposing/ enemy) against God. Rom 8:7
 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. Rom 8:8
6. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God Rom 8:9
 dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of His.
7. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life Rom 8:10
 because of righteousness.
8. For the earnest expectation of the creature (all creation) waiteth for the Rom 8:19
 manifestation (revelation or appearance) of the sons of God.
9. For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a Rom 8:24
 man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?
10. Moreover whom He (God) did predestinate, them He also called: and whom Rom 8:30
 He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified.

C. How do you develop stronger faith to become a Super Conqueror in Christ Jesus?

1. For **by grace are ye saved through faith;** and that not of yourselves: Eph 2:8
it is the gift of God:
2. God hath (already) dealt to every man **the measure of faith.** Rom 12:3
3. The word is nigh thee, even **in thy mouth, and in thy heart:** that Rom 10:8
is, the word of faith, which we preach;
4. **That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in** Rom 10:9
thine heart that God hath raised Him (Jesus) from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
5. For with the **heart man believeth** unto righteousness; and with the **mouth** Rom 10:10
confession is made unto salvation.
6. For the scripture saith, Whosoever **believeth on Him shall not be ashamed.** Rom 10:11
7. No difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all **is rich** Rom 10:12
 (affluent to give blessings of salvation) **unto all that call upon Him (Jesus).**

8. For whosoever **shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.** Rom 10:13
9. So then **faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.** Rom 10:17
10. **Study to shew thyself approved unto God,** a workman that needeth **not to be ashamed,** rightly dividing (teach the truth directly and correctly) the word of truth. 2 Tim 2:15
11. **Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.** Matt 4:4
12. But **if the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you,** He that raised up Christ from the dead **shall also quicken your mortal bodies** by His Spirit that dwelleth in you. Rom 8:11
13. For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: **but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.** Rom 8:13
14. **For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.** Rom 8:14
15. For ye **have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear;** but ye **have received the Spirit of adoption,** whereby we cry, **Abba, Father.** Rom 8:15
16. And if children, then heirs; **heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;** if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together. Rom 8:17
17. For I reckon that the **sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory** which shall be **revealed in us.** Rom 8:18
18. But if we **hope** for that we see not, then do we with **patience** wait for it. Rom 8:25
19. Likewise the **Spirit also helpeth our infirmities (weakness):** for we know not (do not perceive with our eyes, discover, discern, observe, pay attention to,) what we should pray for as we ought: **but the Spirit itself (Himself/Holy Spirit) maketh intercession (in behalf) for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.** Rom 8:26
- 20 And He that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because **He maketh intercession (to light upon)**for the saints according to the will of God. Rom 8:27
21. And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them **who are the called according to His purpose.** Rom 8:28
22. What shall we then say to these things? **If God be for us, who can be against us?** Rom 8:31
- 23 It is **Christ...who also maketh intercession for us.** Rom 8:34
- 24 **Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?** shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Rom 8:35
25. As it is written, For thy sake **we are killed all the day long (by death to be liberated from the bond of anything).** Rom 8:36
26. For **I am persuaded (yield, trust, have confidence in),** that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, **shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.** Rom 8:38
Rom 8:39
27. The centurion answered and said, Lord...**speak the word only,** and my servant **shall be healed.** Matt 8:8
When **Jesus** heard it, He **marvelled, and said...I have not found so great faith.** Matt 8:10
