D. Stand Fast in Your Faith.

Gal 5:1-6

1. Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage. Indeed I, Paul, say to you that if you become circumcised, Christ will profit you nothing. And I testify again to every man who becomes circumcised that he is a debtor to keep the whole law. You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace. For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.

E. Activate Your faith with a Faith Action Plan Because the Just Shall Live by Faith.

1. Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 2:4
2. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." Romans 1:17
3. But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for Galatians 3:11
4. "The just shall live by faith." Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him." Hebrews 10:38
