

Are You An HD'er?

Overview: What is an HD'er? He or She is someone who **Hears** and **Does** the Word of God.

A. Scriptures

Jas 1:21 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

Jas 1:22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Jas 1:23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror;

Jas 1:24 for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

Jas 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues *in it*, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God.**

Joh 1:14 **And the Word became flesh** and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Joh 8:31 Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed.

Joh 8:32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

Heb 13:7 Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct.

Heb 4:2 For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.

Heb 4:12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart

.2Ti 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

2Ti 4:2 Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

B. Believing

Heb 11:1 **Now faith is** the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb 11:6 **But without faith it is impossible to please Him**, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Luk 18:8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, **will He really find faith on the earth?"**

Rom 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Mat 21:20 And when the disciples saw *it*, they marveled, saying, "How did the fig tree wither away so soon?"

Mat 21:21 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, **I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done.**

Mat 21:22 And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."

Mar 11:22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "**Have faith in God.**

Mar 11:23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' **and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done**, he will have whatever he says.

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.

C. With Faith We Move Into Prosperity

Mat 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Luk 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

2Co 9:6 But this *I say*: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and **he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.**

2Co 9:7 So let each one *give* as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; **for God loves a cheerful giver.**

2Co 9:8 And *God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.*

2Co 9:9 As it is written: "**HE HAS DISPERSED ABROAD, HE HAS GIVEN TO THE POOR; HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS ENDURES FOREVER.**"

2Co 9:10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness,

D, Tithing

Mal 3:8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! **But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings.**

Mal 3:9 You are cursed with a curse, For you have robbed Me, *Even* this whole nation.

Mal 3:10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, **And try Me now in this,**" Says the LORD of hosts, "**If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you *such* blessing That *there will not be room enough to receive it.***

Mal 3:11 "And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, So that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, Nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," Says the LORD of hosts;

Mal 3:12 And all nations will call you blessed, For you will be a delightful land," Says the LORD of hosts.

There are benefits to Tithing

1. It loosens the devourer in your life if you don't tithe.
2. It breaks the curse on your life.
3. It brings deliverance (Abraham; Achan)
4. It brings healing.
5. It is the doorway to financial blessings of God.
6. We need to Worship and Honor Him.
