

How to Build Your Faith to Prosper

- A. Start Building Your Faith by Possessing the Promises of God and You Will Prosper.
1. What cities do you own?
 2. Are you as challenged as the Israelites were prior to entering the Promised Land with doubt and unbelief?
 3. God promises to bless us with complete provision.
 - a. I have given you a land for which you did not labor, and cities which you did not build, and you dwell in them; you eat of the vineyards and olive groves which you did not plant. Joshua 24:13
 4. A hindrance to building your faith to prosper is complacency or prosperity.
 - a. For the turning away of the simple will slay them, And the complacency/prosperity of fools will destroy them. Proverbs 1:32
But whoever listens to me will dwell safely, and will be secure (*with quietness, peace, rest and ease*), without fear of evil. KJV/NKJV
Proverbs 1:33
 - b. Strong's Concordance Definition #H7962 – Complacency means in the Hebrew translation of “*shalvah*” is “*prosperity, quietness, ease, genuine or false security.*”
 - c. Dictionary of Bible Themes Definition 5810 – Complacency means “*A self-satisfied state of negligence or carelessness, especially in relation to one's personal situation.*”
 - d. Merriam Webster's Definition - Complacency means “*self-satisfaction especially when accompanied by unawareness (or not being informed) of actual dangers or deficiencies. When it comes to safety, complacency can be dangerous.*”
 5. Do not be like many Christians who become complacent.
 - a. Be sober, be vigilant; because[a] your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 1 Peter 5:8
 - b. Resist him (the devil), steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world. 1 Peter 5:9
- B. Continue Building Your Faith and You Will Prosper.
1. Increase Your Faith. Luke 17:5
 2. Babes do not prosper, are not successful and do not take dominion.
 - a. For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. Hebrews 5:13
 3. Here at ABC Church we are fed not just meat, but the strong meat of the WOG (Word of God).
 - a. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. Hebrews 5:14
 4. When you are a doer to continue building your faith, you will be blessed.
 - a. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does. James 1:25

C. Finish Building Your Faith and You Will Prosper.

1. Using God's power, which comes from Him through you, makes you strong.
 - a. Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Ephesians 6:10
2. When you speak the WOG, He prospers it and makes everything you do successful.
 - a. So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it. Isaiah 55:11
3. Faith in your faith-filled words will dictate your terms in a greater way.
 - a. Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. John 14:11
 - b. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. John 14:12
 - c. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. John 14:13
4. Wherever you are, no matter the circumstances, God will bless you exponentially a hundredfold.
 - a. Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year a hundredfold; and the LORD blessed him Genesis 26:12
5. God will bless a faithful doer of the Word to become very prosperous.
 - a. The man began to prosper, and continued prospering until he became very prosperous; Genesis 26:13
 - b. For he had possessions of flocks and possessions of herds and a great number of servants. So the Philistines envied him. Genesis 26:14
 - c. All Believers who are Tithers, Doers of the Word and true Disciples as Manifested Sons and Daughters of God should be this prosperous because this demonstrates godly authority and dominion over the earth, the underworld and the heavenlies.

D. Which Servant Are You Going to Be, a Fearful Goat or a Faithful Sheep?

1. The servant who works in fear as a wicked and lazy servant.
 - a. And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground... Matthew 25:25
 - b. But his lord answered and said to him, you wicked and lazy servant. Matthew 25:26
2. The servants who operate in faith to prosper their Lord's kingdom.
 - a. His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord. Matthew 25:21
